Whatcha need to shoot this Quote, "Unofficial" Unquote, category? Well, ah'll tell ya:

Handguns: ALL SASSlegal handguns are allowed.

Rifles: Any SASS-legal rifle of 1886 or LATER design or replica of: 1892, 1894, Lightning Rifle or a Marlin.

Shotgun: All SASS-legal shotguns

Ammo: All SASS-legal ammo is allowed

Leather: Buscadero rigs OR drop-loop rigs. (ALL of the pistola must be carried BELOW the TOP of the gun belt.) All belt and holster rigs MUST be "embellished" (Conchos, Spots or Fancy Tooling). All holsters must be of the "straight-hang" type. No cross-draws or shoulder rigs.

Shooting Style: Any NON-gunfighter shooting style.

Clothing:

Shirts: must be of the "B" Western style with snap buttons or any of the following: "Smiley Pockets", embroidered, appliqués, fringe or different-colored yokes. Shield shirts are allowed if they have piping or fringe.

Pants: must be jeans, ranch pants or pants with flap over rear pocket, keystone belt loops and/ or piping or fringe. Pants must be worn with a BELT. No suspenders allowed.

Hats: Felt only, no straws. Hats must be worn.

Boots: Must be of traditional design with fancy stitching or multi-color fancy design with smooth, non-grip (lug) soles. Lace-up boots are not allowed.

Western spurs with rowels are required for men.

Ladies may also wear skirts or split riding pants.

You must choose at least one or more of the following optional items:

Gloves or Gauntlets,

Is a second sight bead, located half-way down the barrel rib on shotguns, SASS-Legal?

Some shotguns come from the factory with this second bead installed. The consensus of opinion on the T/G Wire is that if the bead is of "legal" materials, such as brass, ivory or steel, that it is legal and really does not present any advantage in the distances we shoot.
