# Dispatches from the Territorial Governors

Recent questions have been raised on the SASS T/G Wire about "Double Taps".

This applies to Rifle, Pistol AND Shotgun stages.

A double tap procedural depends on how the stage is written and the shooting string is defined. Clear stage directions to covey the writer's intent are very important. It takes a bit of work to write a stage that is clear and does not contain hidden short cuts or differing interpretations.

First example (good): For a ten shot pistol string -

"Shoot the four pistol targets for 10 shots, engaging each target at least once, any order, no double taps."

It is clear, across the ten pistol shots, no target can be hit two times in a row, regardless of pistol used.

Second example (good): For two five shot strings - "Shoot the three pistol targets for five shots, engaging each target at least once, any order, no double taps. Holster. Draw second pistol and repeat."

In this scenario, the double tap only occurs within the five shot string since it is defined that way. Where the shooter starts the second five shot

string is his choice. He could choose to Nevada sweep the targets twice, starting on the same side each time.

Third example (confusing): "Shoot the five targets in a sweep from either direction with the first pistol. Holster. Draw second pistol, and sweep the same targets. Holster. NO DOUBLE TAPS!"

In the third example, it appears the writer intended to have a ten shot string, since there is no way to shoot five targets with five shots and need the clarifying statement "No double taps" ("No double taps" also appears at the end of the second (continued on Page 4)

pistol description, hence applying to the whole 10 shot string). A shooter when then get a procedural for a left to right sweep, then a right to left sweep.

## How does a stage designer overcome this "procedural trap"?:

- 1. Eliminate the "No Double Tap" statement. Or,
- 2. Clearly define whether it is two five shot strings or a ten shot string. Or,
- 3. Designate that both sweeps be from the same direction.

The question of whether it is two five shot strings or a ten shot string comes up the most due to gunfighters. Under current rules, Gunfighters engage the same targets, in the same order, with any combination of pistols, as any other shooting class.
