Forty (40) Cowboys

and Cowgirls braved the cold to shoot November's monthly match. It warmed up quickly after the sun burned off the morning fog and the 40 shooters shot their way thru 5 creative stages.

Stage 1, by Col. Cornelius Gilliam had the shooter using 2 pistols and 1 shotgun to blast thru 12 targets. This consisted of 2 pistol sweeps on 5 targets and a minimum of 12 rounds from the shotgun (more if the shooter had misses to

make up). The fastest time on this stage was by Ramblin' Dave with a time of 36.19.

On Stage 2, by Harley Davidson, the shooter had to protect their turkey from a band of Indians. This stage was 10 pistol shots, 10 rifle shots and just 2 shotgun rounds - the fastest time being. again, Ramblin' Dave who shot it in 23.11seconds. Extraordinaire" and the shooter was trying to walk in his footsteps. This stage used only 7 targets and 4 of those were for the shotgun. The shooter shot the four shotgun targets and then 9 shots from the rifle at which point the shooter moved laterally to shoot rounds out of their pistols. The fastest time on this stage was by Purgatory Smith who shot it in 28.49 seconds!

On **Stage 4**, by H. Apple Bob, the shooter had a series of Nevada sweeps and a small bo-

nus target that had to be shot, with the rifle, in the "off" hand! The Col smoked his way to top speed honors on this stage. Blowing smoke rings thru 10 pistol shots, 9 (plus the bonus reload) rifle rounds and 4 shotgun rounds in just 29.41 seconds! Did I mention the bonus target was small?

Stage 5 by Jed I. Knight had the shooters fumbling inside a turkey to "fish" out the shotgun shells needed to defend his property from invaders. These
