January's shoot had 34 shooters. Everybody enjoyed relatively mild weather, especially in comparison to December's shoot! Thanks to all who helped out with hauling steel in and out again this month!

Stage one, JSR's "shotgun stage" was written by none other than JD Walker. 14 shotgun rounds and 10 pistol rounds were shot on this stage with Purgatory Smith having the fastest time of 41.24 seconds.

Col. Cornelius Gilliam wrote stage two 10 rounds rifle, 10 rounds pistol and 6 rounds from

the shotgun. This stage's fastest time was by Ramblin' Dave who managed to shoot it in just 33.38 seconds.

Stage three was written by Bear Bone Smith, 6 rounds of shotgun, 10 rounds pistol and 10 rounds rifle, fastest time on this stage was by Purgatory Smith; he shot it in just 23.88 seconds.

Stage four was written by MT Dawson, this stage started with 5 rounds of shotgun, followed by 10 rounds from the rifle and then 10 shots from the pistols. This stage was shot by MT Dawson in 37.63 seconds (hmm... stage writer and fastest shooter on the same stage...)

Stage five was written by Jed I. Knight, this stage consisted of 10 pistol shots from a seated position, 10 rifle shots and a minimum of 4 shotgun rounds. The fastest time on the stage was by Purgatory Smith; he shot it in 32.20 seconds.

Congratulations to our THREE shooters who managed a clean match, Bear Bone Smith (3rd Overall and 1 st place "Traditional"), Treacherous Jack (5th Overall and 2nd place "Traditional") and Jed I. Knight (8th Overall and 1st place "Frontier Cartridge Duelist").
