Twenty Howdy all! shooters showed up to eniov ISR's May monthly match.

In the absence of our Match Director we took a scenario out of the book for Stage One; the ISR "Shotgun Stage". This stage, written by Cornelius, required 2 pistols loaded with 5-rounds each and one shotgun with a minimum of 12-rounds. Fastest time on the stage was by Purgatory who shot it in 36.84 seconds.

Stage Two was written by first-time-scenariowriter **Treacherous** Tack. This stage required 10 pistol rounds, 10 rifle rounds and at least 6 shotgun rounds. Fastest time on this stage was by Purgatory who shot it in 31.81 seconds.

Stage Three, the Overland Express, was written bv Sourdough Smitty. This stage required 10 rounds from two pistols, 10 rounds from the lever gun and 6 rounds from the shotgun. Fastest time on this stage was by Bear Bone Smith who shot it in 37.38 seconds.

Stage Four was written by **Harley Davidson**. Her stage, Picnic on the Range, had the shooter hunting for picnic grub on the range. This stage required rounds in the rifle, 10rounds in two pistols and 3 rounds in the shotgun. Fastest time

on this stage was by Ramblin' Dave who shot it in 22.53 seconds!

Stage Five was written by me. This stage had the shooter defending homestead their against an Indian attack. This stage required the shooter to fire 10 rounds from their rifle, 10 pistol rounds and a minimum of 4 rounds from the shotgun. Fastest time was by **Purgatory** who shot it in 31.12 seconds.
