Howdy all! 25 Shooters came out to JUNE'S JSR Monthly match, including a Buckaroo (**Kid Gunslinger**), a Buckarette (**Kookanadude**)!

The top three shooters for March's match were; 3rd place, Bear Bone Smith (Traditional); 2nd place, Ramblin' Dave (Senior) and 1st place Purgatory Smith (Gunfighter)

Of course, as always, I want to say a special thanks to all of our stage writers and to those that show up early to help set up steel and stay after to help us tear down steel.

Several stage scenarios

this month had a similar plot device. It seems that with the change in the weather the Steel Horse has been a popular topic, in both conversations and popping up (albeit hidden at times) in stage descriptions.

Stage 1, "Chasing Rebels" was written by Sourdough Smitty. Stage requirements were 10 pistol rounds and 14 shotgun rounds. Fastest time was Ramblin' Dave with who shot it in exactly 41 seconds.

Stage 2, "Taking Care of the Dirty Laundry" was written by Kookanadude. Stage requirements were 10 pistol rounds, 4 shotgun rounds and 9 rifle rounds. The fastest time on the stage was 22.89 seconds by Purgatory Smith.

Stage 3, "Father's Day Ride" was written by Checotah. Stage ammo requirements were 10 pistol rounds, 10 rifle rounds (including 1 round reloaded on the clock) and 6 shotgun rounds. Fastest time was Purgatory Smith at 32.57 seconds.

Stage 4, "Diamond Jack" was written by Col. Cornelius Gilliam. Stage ammo requirements were 10 pistol rounds, 10 rifle rounds and 6 shotgun rounds. Fastest time was 33.74 seconds by Ramblin' Dave.
